THE VENUE – ESTONIAN GOLF & COUNTRY CLUB

Opened in 2005, the Estonian Golf & Country Club (EGCC) is the finest and the most distinctive golf resort in Estonia, and part of the the European Tour Properties and World of Leading Golf. The club offers golfers an 18 hole championship level Sea Course and a 9 hole links style Stone Course.

For 4 consecutive years, Golf World magazine has selected our Sea Course as among Continental Europe's Top 100 Golf Courses.

The Sea Course has twice hosted the Omega Mission Hills World Cup European Qualifier, in 2009 and 2011 where keenly contested matches between European Tour players like Joost Luiten, Robert-Jan Derksen, Felipe Aguilar, Mark Tullo, David Drysdale, Stephen Todd, Graham DeLaet, Jamie Donaldson, Alastair Forsyth and Jose Filipe Lima.

The club has a great access from Estonian capital Tallinn and is situated just 20 km from the city centre.

THE CLUB AND THE COURSES

Sea Course

Sea Course, with its 18 holes stretching over 6500 meters (7,100 yards), is a true championship golf course, the perfect location for the European Amateur Championship 2016.

Holes built beside unspoiled forests reach out to the seashore and to the Jägala River. The elevation changes, oak-chip pathways, ice-age boulders and natural water hazards have given the Estonian Golf & Country Club a chance to create a golf course like few others in the world. With its length and complexity, the Sea Course is a real challenge even for the best golfers.

Stone Course

On the limestone plain, between junipers, reconstructed stone fences and heritage signs under national protection, you can find a special 9-hole golf course with various tales to tell. Stone Course, opened to winds, has an air of links spirits that is so common to traditional British courses. As a balancing factor, various heritage signs and findings tell their stories about Estonia hundreds of years back in time.



The Future

In 2019 the new Annika Course designed by Annika Sörenstam and European Golf Design (EDG) will open at Estonian Golf & Country Club.

Annika Sörenstam's achievements rank her as one of the most successful female golfers in history. She won 90 international tournaments as a professional, making her the player with the most wins to her name in the ladies' game.

"The golf industry has been talking a lot about the need to develop golf facilities that are more flexible and family friendly, and Estonian Golf & Country Club is actually going to make it happen," said Annika, 10-time major champion.

"My objective is to create a course that good golfers will find a strategic challenge, as well as visually appealing, while the design will utilize a variety of forward tees to make it equally enjoyable and engaging for newer golfers and young players. Ultimately, the layout will offer great versatility, from tournament play to resort golf, giving all golfers, no matter how far they hit the ball, a world-class experience."

In the next few years the Sea Course will also get a facelift from our architect Lassi Pekka Tilander. He was the first Finnish golf course architect to join the ranks of the European Institute of Golf Course Architects.





Clubhouse

The facilities of the Clubhouse will be extended to players, Championship Committee, championship staff, sponsors, guests and press for the duration of the championship. The Clubhouse with dressing rooms, restaurant etc. will be open daily from 6:00 to 22:00.



Dress Code

A reasonable standard of dress is expected at all times, both on the course and in the Clubhouse. Jeans, sleeveless or collarless shirts and tracksuites are not permitted on the course. Only soft spikes are permitted on the course. The Welcome and Farewell Cocktails will be informal.

Information Boards

The Official Notice Board will be located in the Clubhouse. There will be information boards at the reception of the official hotels. Players should have a look at the information boards at regular intervals as important information will be displayed relating to tee-times, messages etc.

Internet Access

A complimentary wireless internet access is available in the Clubhouse area and in the official hotels.

The official practice days are Monday, 1st and Tuesday, 2nd August. Please reserve your tee-time for the practice rounds directly at the golf club office: info@egcc.ee or by filling in the players requirement form.



Practice Facilities

A practice putting green, practice bunker and a short game area as well as a full driving range are available next to the Clubhouse. Tournament packages for players include unlimited range balls and a pull trolley for the championship week. However, it is also possible to separately purchase range balls (\in 60 unlimited golfballs or \in 3 per 25 balls) and pull-trolleys (\in 3 per day). Electric trollies are available for \in 25 per day.

Registration

Registration is open on Monday, 1st August from 8:00-20:00 and on Tuesday, 2nd August from 8:00-12:00.

Competitors are requested to register at the Clubhouse immediately upon arrival but not later than 12:00 on Tuesday, 2nd August 2016. A competitor's failure to meet this dead-line or to pre-notify the Committee of his pending arrival time may result in the competitor losing his place in the starting field.

Tournament office

The tournament office is open on Monday and Tuesday from 8:00 - 20:00 and Wednesday to Saturday from 6:30 - 20:00.

Transportation

A daily shuttle service will operate from the official hotels to and from the golf course. Transfer schedule will be attached on the separate sheet in the player's portfolio. ABOUT ESTONIA

Some facts about Estonia

- Geographically, Estonia is on the north-eastern edge of the European Union, bordering Russia and Latvia
- The official language is Estonian, though everyone in tourism speaks good English and often German, Russian and Finnish too!
- Since 2011, the official currency in Estonia is Euro
- Estonia is in the Schengen Area so we have open borders with the rest of Europe
- In 2011 the capital of Estonia, Tallinn, was the European Capital of Culture
 - Tallinn has a mystic and mesmerizing Medieval Old Town. Most of the cobblestone
- streets and buildings dating back as far as the 11th century, are preserved in their original form.
- In 2012 the World Health Organization issued a global air quality ranking and Estonia
 was ranked 1st place: the cleanest air in the world.



How to get there

Travelling to Estonia is easy – by plane, train, automobile or boat (ferries and cruises).

Citizens from EU, USA, New Zealand, Canada or Australia do not need a visa to enter and neither do you need one, if you are travelling with a Schengen visa.

The biggest international airport in Estonia is located in Tallinn and you can fly direct from most major cities in Europe.
