

#### **ESTONIAN JUNIOR TOUR 2022**

#### 1. GENERAL

# 1.1 Date and place

\* – One of Junior Tour stages is Estonian Junior Open for U12, U16 and U21 competition classes and the rules apply according to the Estonian Junior Open competition instructions. The Estonian Junior Open does not count in U9 competition classes.

#### 1.2 Format

The winners of each competition (stage) shall be decided over 18 holes (9 holes for U9) in stroke play in accordance with the rules of golf as approved by R&A Rules Limited, the Estonian Golf Association hard card, Code of conduct, the local rules approved by the Committee of the Championship and the conditions herein. Max score rule (10 strokes) is in use in all competition classes.

### 1.3 Winner and prizes

The winners of the championship (Tour) shall be the Estonian Junior Tour champions. The first three places in the competition classes will be awarded with prizes. In addition, the first three places in each competition class of each stage will be awarded with prizes.

### 1.4 Eligibility, classes, tees

Entries will be accepted from any junior amateur players. All competitors must have WHS HCP Index.



The Estonian Junior Tour will be held in eight classes:

U9 (boys) born 2013 and later (special tees)

U12 (boys) born 2010 and later (blue tees)

U16 (boys) born 2006 and later (yellow tees)

U21 (boys) born 2001 and later (white tees)

U9 (girls) born 2013 and later (special tees)

U12 (girls) born 2010 and later (red tees)

U16 (girls) born 2006 and later (red tees)

U21 (girls) born 2001 and later (blue tees)

#### 1.5 Caddies

Caddies mandatory in U9 class, recommended in U12. In U16 and U21 class caddies are not allowed.

#### 1.6 Decision of ties

If the medal places of the Tour are shared by two or more competitors with equal results, then their rankings will be determined under the principle better result on the last 36, 18, 9, 6, 3 and 1 holes. If the tie remains, the better result is decided by lot.

In case of a tie for the HCP Strokeplay special prize, the competitors' handicaps (PHCP) will be compared. If that's equal, the competitors' HCPI will be compared. Preference will be given to the player with lower PHCP or HCPI respectively. If the tie remains, the better result is decided by lot.

### 1.7 Leaderboard points

Points for the general classification of the tour are calculated on the principle (place, points):

In the case of tied places, the competitor gets the average of the scores of the places in the table. For example, in case of a 7th-8th place tie, both players will receive 31 points in the standings. The points obtained are rounded to a whole number if necessary.

The points obtained on the Estonian Junior Open will have a double value. The results of the six best stages (five of the U9 competition classes) will be taken into account.

At the end of the season, if two players have the same number of points, the first places of the stages are compared, if necessary the second places, etc.

### 1.8 Competition Committee

Exceptionally, the Competition Committee has the right to make changes to the conditions of competition.

### 2. PARTICIPATION

#### 2.1 Entries

# 2.2 Entry fee

Entry fee is 25€ for U21 and U16. Free (0€) for U12 and U9 participants.



### 2.3 Withdrawal and refunds

To withdraw from the competition, the organizer of the competition must be notified by e-mail: tournament@golf.ee

Cancellation of participation before the competition registration deadline - 100% of the entry fee will be refunded.

Cancellation of participation after the competition registration deadline, but before the tee-times are published - 75% of the entry fee will be refunded.

Cancellation of participation after the tee-times are published - participation fee is not refunded. Failure to appear in the U9 and U12 age classes may result in sanctions.
