



ESTONIAN JUNIOR TOUR

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

1. GENERAL

1.1 Format

The winners of each competition (stage) shall be decided over 18 holes (9 holes for U9) in stroke play in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by R&A Rules Limited, the Estonian Golf Association Hard Card and Code of Conduct, the Local Rules approved by the Committee, Generic Terms and the Conditions herein. The maximum score rule (10 strokes) is used in all competition classes. Except in the final stage, U21 and U16 age classes.

1.2 Eligibility, classes and tees

Entries will be accepted from any junior amateur players who own WHS™ H.I.™ can participate in the competition.

The competition will be held in eight classes:

- U9 (boys) born 2017 and later
- U12 (boys) born 2014 and later
- U16 (boys) born 2010 and later
- U21 (boys) born 2005 and later
- U9 (girls) born 2017 and later
- U12 (girls) born 2014 and later
- U16 (girls) born 2010 and later
- U21 (girls) born 2005 and later

1.3 Decision of ties

If the medal places of the Tour are shared by two or more competitors with equal results, then their rankings will be determined under the principle better result on the last 36, 18, 9, 6, 3 and 1 holes. If the tie remains, the better result is decided by lot.

In case of a tie for the HCP Strokeplay special prize, the competitors' handicaps (PHCP) will be compared. If that's equal, the competitors' HCPI will be compared. Preference will be given to the player with lower PHCP or HCPI respectively. If the tie remains, the better result is decided by lot.



1.4 Leaderboard points

Points for the general classification of the tour are calculated on the principle (place, points):

In the case of tied places, the competitor gets the average of the scores of the places in the table. For example, in case of a 7th-8th place tie, both players will receive 31 points in the standings. The points obtained are rounded to a whole number if necessary.

The Estonian Junior Open is a competition for U12, U16 and U21 age groups and the rules are in accordance with the Estonian Junior Open Competition Rules. The Estonian Junior Open does not include U9 classes. Points obtained at the Estonian Junior Open will have a double value.

Points obtained in the Estonian Junior Tour Final will be added to the standings with a value of 1.5x.

The results of the six best stages (five for U9) will be taken into account in the overall Tour standings.

At the end of the season, if two players have the same number of points, the first places of the stages are compared, if necessary, the second places, etc. If the tie then persists, the result of the last stage will be checked, if necessary, followed by the penultimate stage, etc.

1.5 Caddies

Caddies' mandatory in U9 class, recommended in U12. In U16 and U21 class caddies are not allowed.



2. PRIZES

2.1 Winner

The winners of the championship (Tour) shall be the Estonian Junior Tour champions. The first three places in the competition classes will be awarded with prizes. In addition, the first three places in each competition class of each stage will be awarded with prizes.
